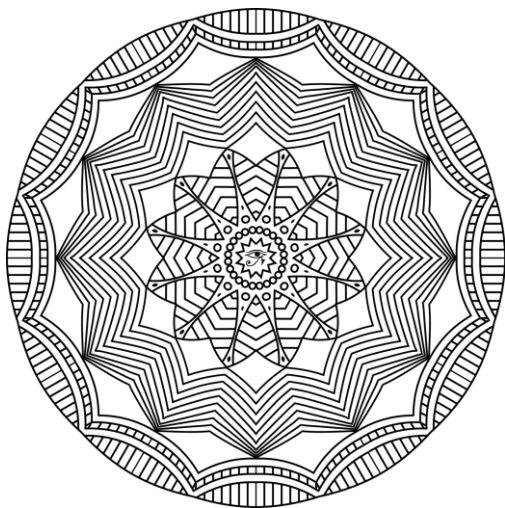

**noun; spiritual saying or teaching, typically Hindu, Buddhist or Taoist.**

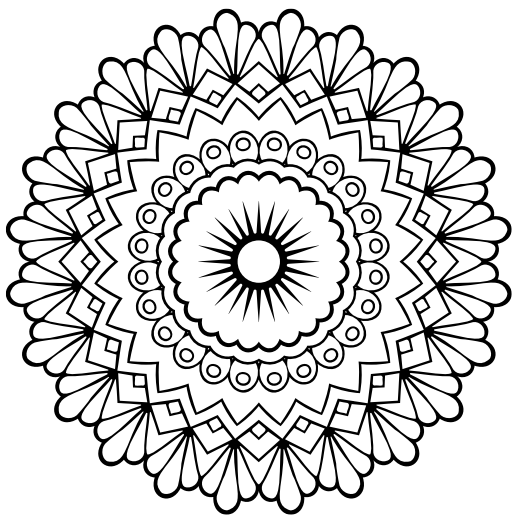

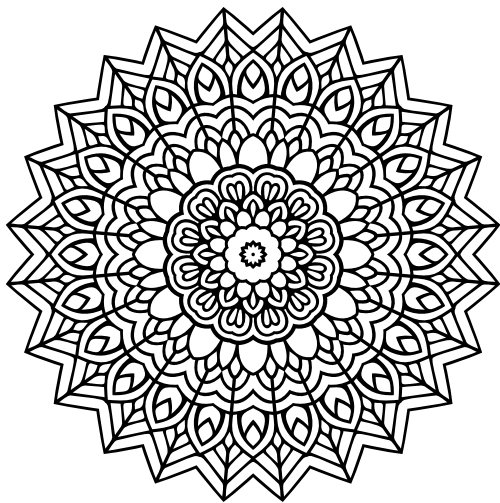




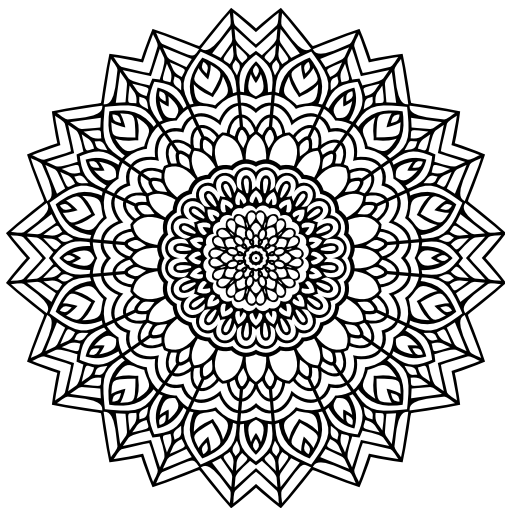
**Turn your ears inwards.**



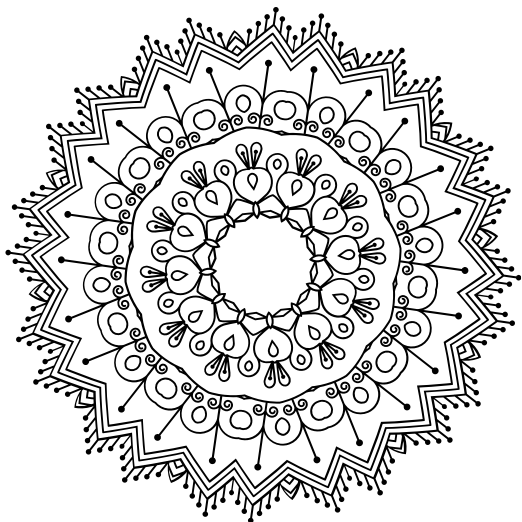

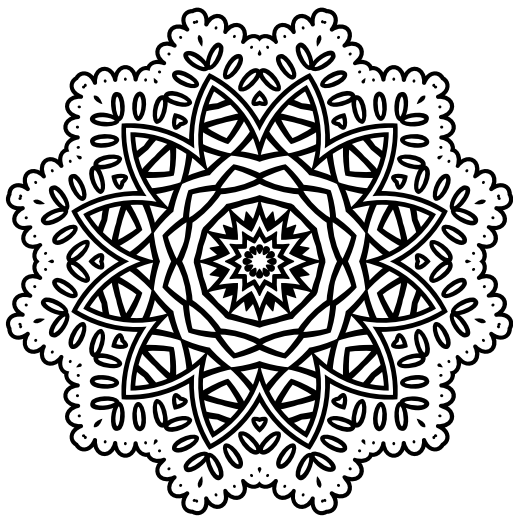


**Spirit is as slight as nothing, as vast as everything. Thus, be your slightest self, and thereby draw nearer to God.**

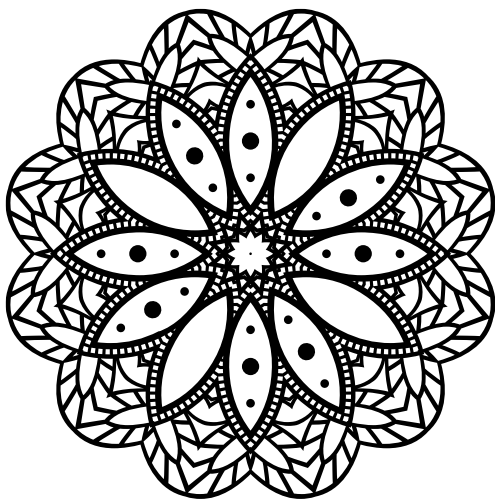




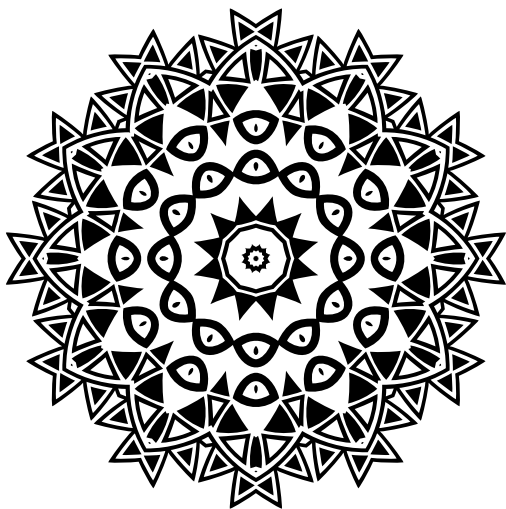

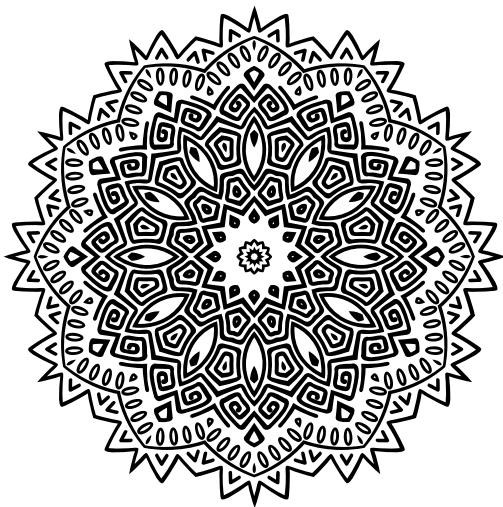




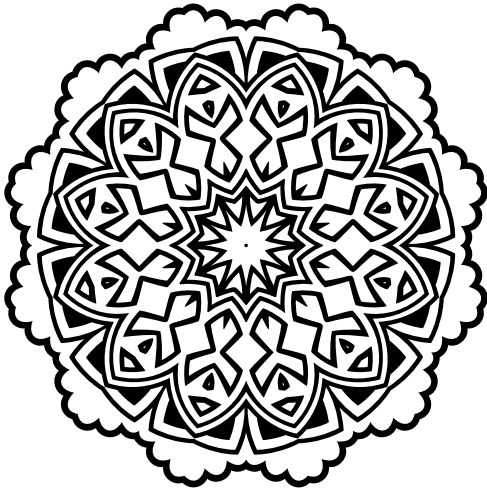
**Success is having nothing to prove.

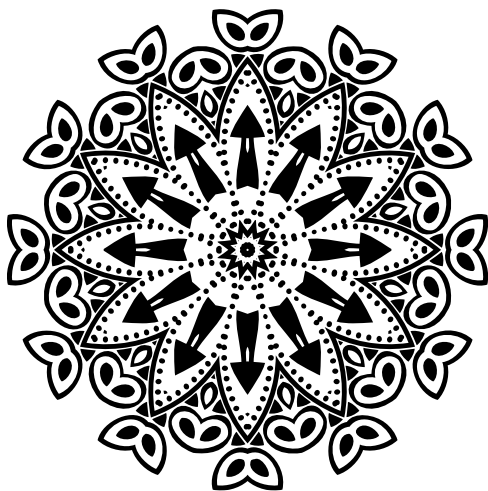




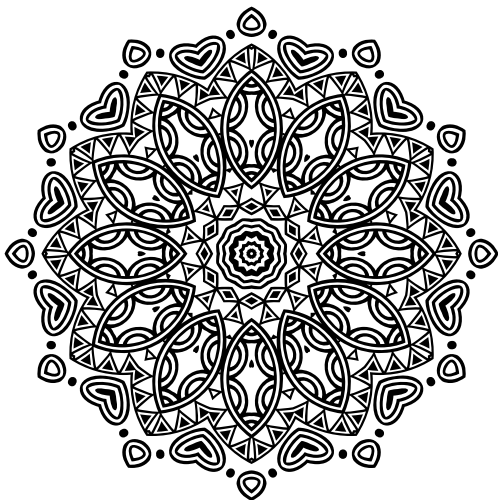
**Sex solely for the sake of physical gratification debases us. But when compelled by love, sex is a gateway to God, and represents a form of worship.**



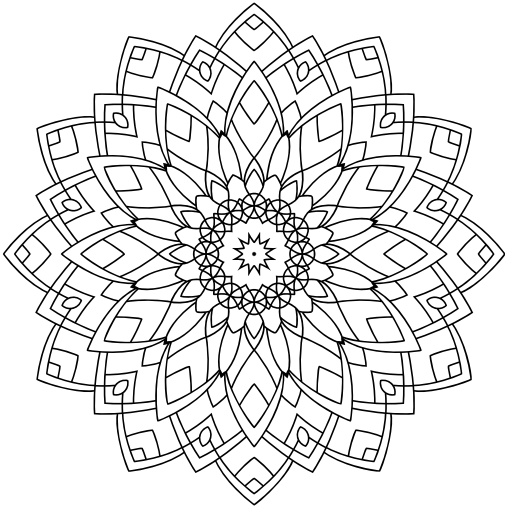
**We are equaled by our

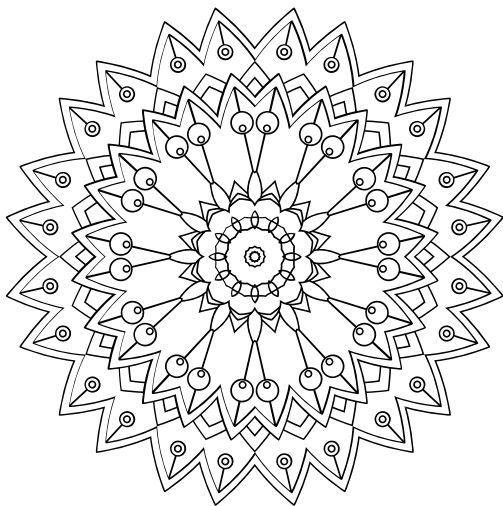
**We ever move towards the light.

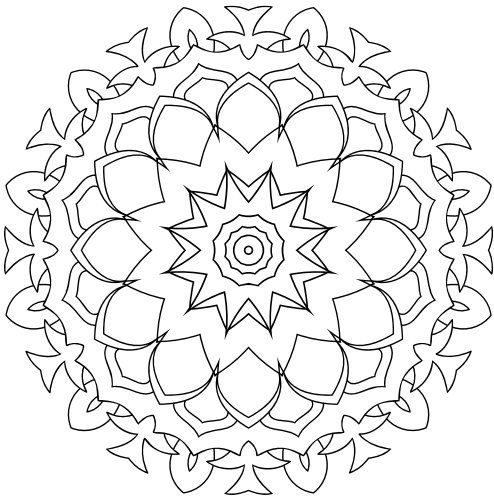
## **Less is more for three fundamental reasons:**

- (3) The more that you have what you don't need, appreciate or make full use of, the more your possession burdens you by its unnecessary weight, thereby making you less**

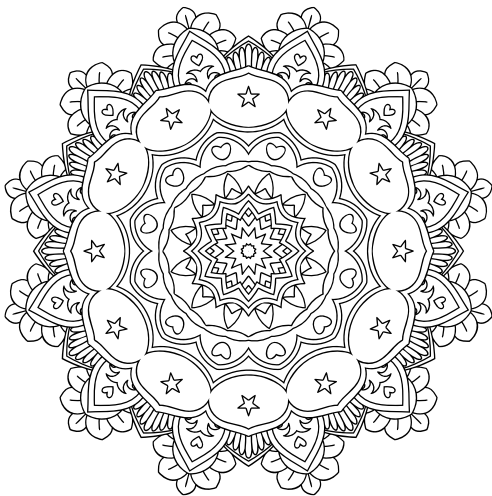

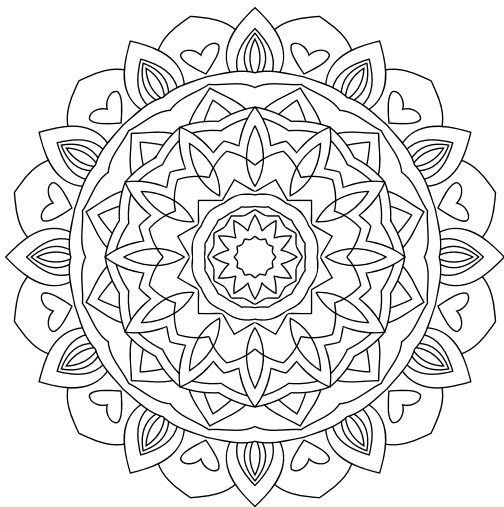
**Drawing near to the peak of irony, we find that the 'land of freedom' is the land of those most enslaved by the aggrandized, accentuated needs that they need not have.**

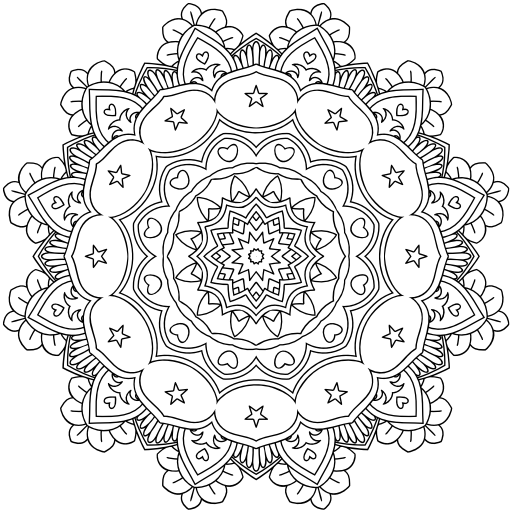

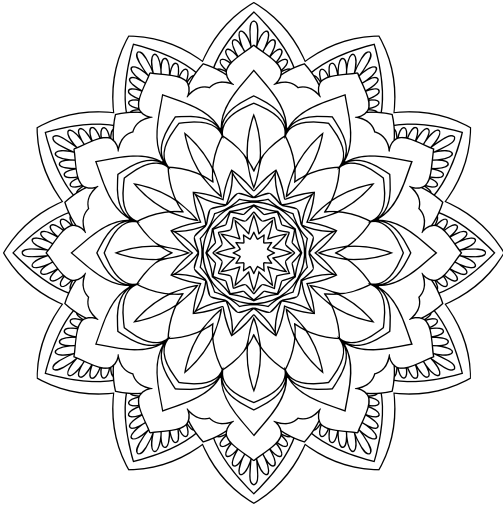




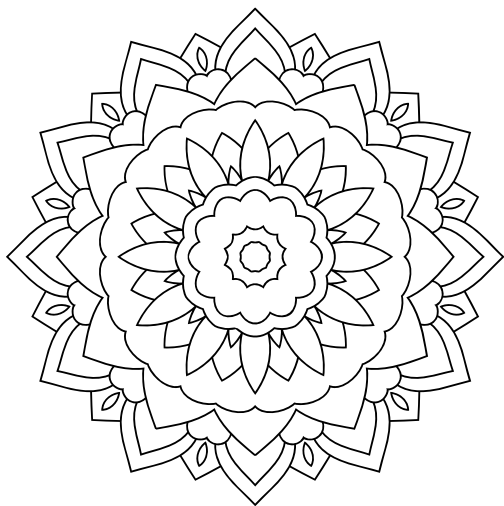
**The curse of the ego is to possess no value without being perceived by others as possessing it.**



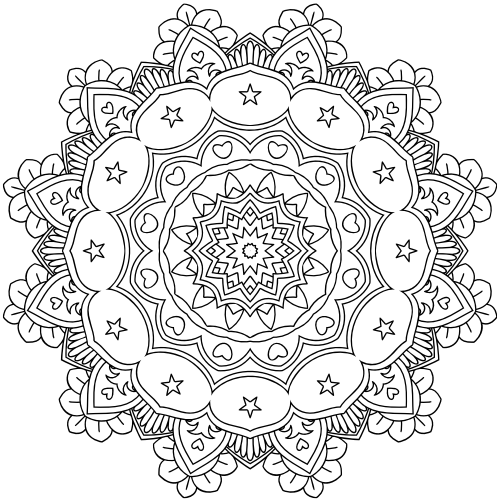

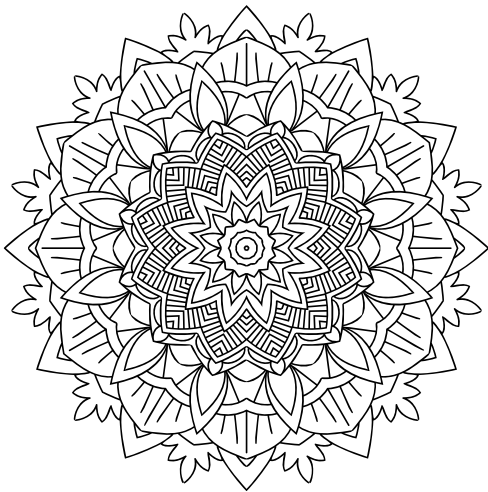
**God groans with the weight borne by the gratuitous gratifications of its infinite finite forms. To jettison that weight is to be borne more by the ever weightless One.**

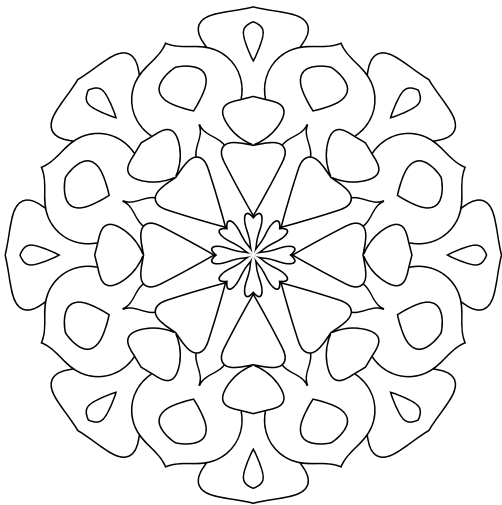




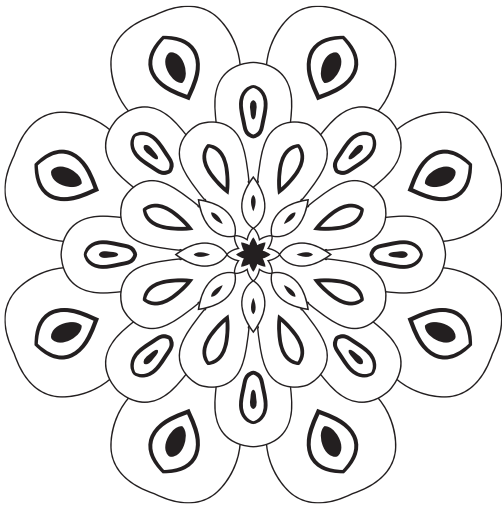
**(1 of 4) Religion actually has more in common with science than with spirituality. By their strict sets of practice and proffering, both are attempts to sell a specificity and certainty that don't actually exist, and that're reductive in nature, thus reducing the minds of those whom come to believe in them. True spirituality, in contrast, that which mirrors God, is about the inherent value of the quest to know God and the universal principles which are as God's appendages. Spirituality free from religion has no specificity or certainty to sell, for its adherent knows that the infinite variance of infinitude is entirely without such constraining specificity and certainty. Spirituality doesn't need to be right, for both right and wrong are delusions of the relative perception of the limited, sentient self whom fails to surmise that the Self of which he/she is inseparable may make wrongs of all of his/her perceived rights when it points at them from opposite angles of perception. Only by seeing any truth from every possible angle may it near the truth.**



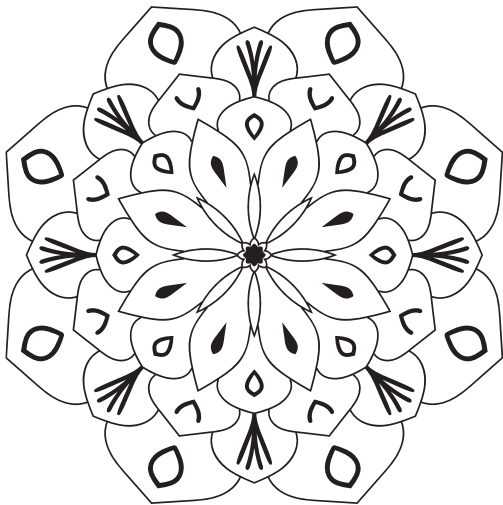
**(2 of 4) Unlike pure, open, unconstrained spirituality, science, like religion, attempts to reduce, contain and confine reality to what may be measured and tested, just as religion reduces, contains and confines totality into what it can control and lay claim to. Both religion and science thereby enforce an illusion of understanding and control, erroneously drawing boundaries around the boundless. Any idea, force or phenomenon that doesn't fit can't be acknowledged as possessing any possibility of legitimacy, and so is discarded as 'unreal,' even as the history of science is defined by the seeming 'discovery' of what has ALWAYS been there, and even as the experience of spirituality is unique to every person, and perfectly customized by the particular contents and capacity of their consciousness, and its inseparability from the One consciousness, God, or Spirit. Both science and religion, in other words, are ideologies granting illegitimate certainties based upon exclusion, reduction and the pretense of control of that which submits to NONE of these constraints. For that which constitutes everything will never be able to fit into but a portion of itself.**



**(3 of 4) It's not that the conclusions pressed upon us by religion and science have no value to life, but that the cost of believing their absolutism is the closing off of the mind sharing those conclusions; a closing off to a wholeness which it can never find whilst suffering the absolutist delusion; a closing off to any facets of truth and reality which are 'unorthodox,' or as of yet 'unfound' and/or 'unproven.' It thereby renders the adherent small in his or her self-assurance, for they're falsely certain of a whole which is but the smallest fraction of the unbounded Self of which they're inseparable. Moreover, much of what they're certain of is as much a part of their ignorance as what they're entirely unaware of, for much of what they regard as 'unreal' is as real as anything which they desperately grasp onto as absolutely certain.**

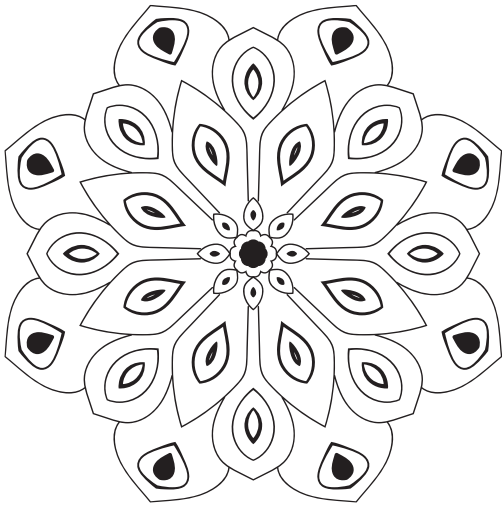


**(4 of 4) As Lachman said based upon his study of the 'scientific mystic' Swedenborg: "What is real for science is that which accommodates the criteria of scientific measurement." In the same way what is real for religion is that which accommodates the criteria of its particular theological paradigm. As the all-encompassing source without beginning or end, the seed of total possibility, Spirit (and therefore any true discussion of spirituality) requires no accommodation, and scoffs at having to make accommodations to the aforementioned in order to have a dialogue with its adherents. Spirituality must constrain itself to pretend to fit within traditional theological conceptions and the dominant realist and materialist paradigms of modernity. For both science and religion are closed, self-affirming systems logically dependent upon their own criteria, as all ideologies are, to some degree, RELATIVE TO THEIR ILLEGITAMACY. Thus, the goal of ideology, especially spiritual ideology, is to construct frameworks from universally-applicative principles as near to representing absolute (irrelative), perfectly inclusive truths as possible, so that the resultant definitions, discourse and outcomes are as comprehensive and mutualistic as possible.**

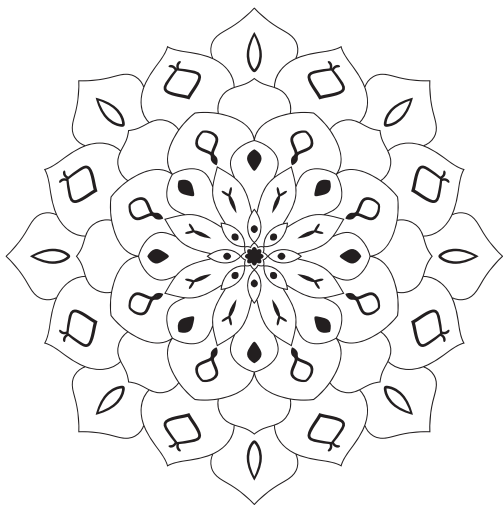




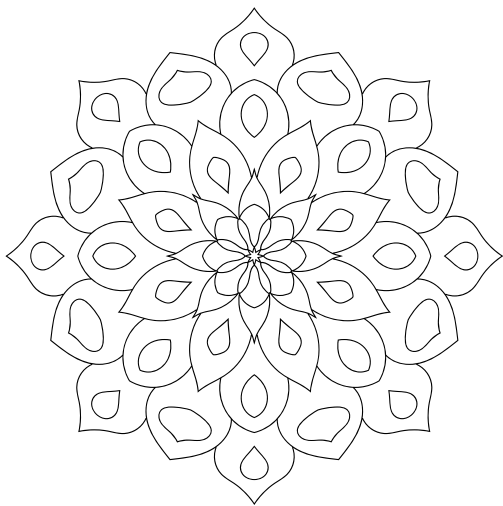
**What is lighter than the air,

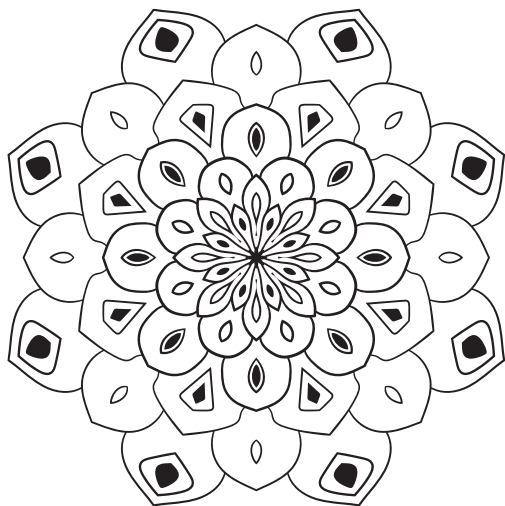
**God is running an existential experiment in order to know Itself; to see Itself from infinite possible vantage points, and thereby come to know totality through the illusion of individuality.**

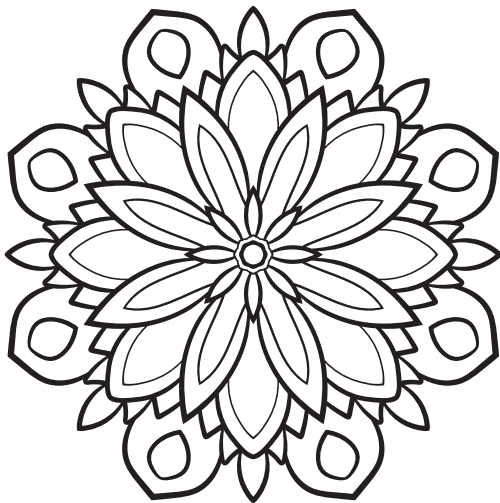

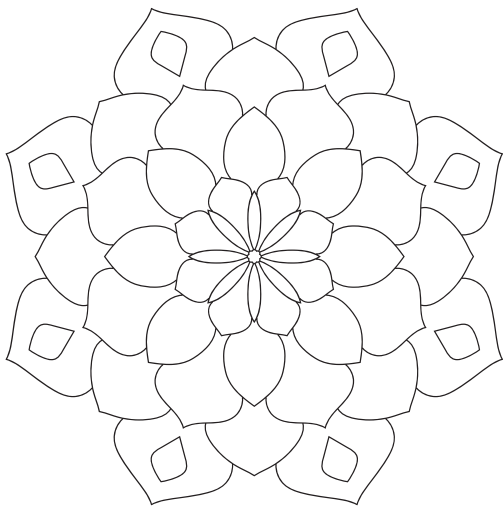




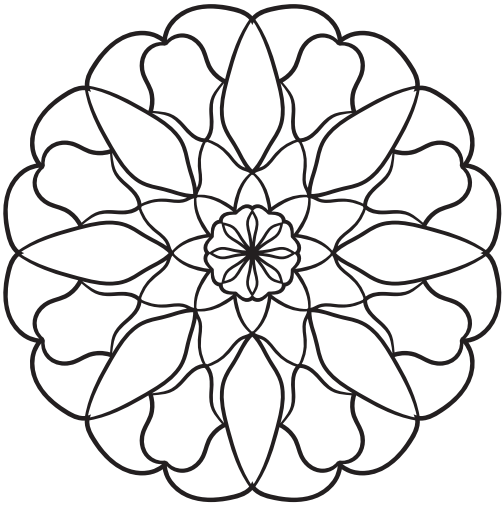

**The Trinity of Self states that every human being is comprised of three intertwined selves: body, mind and Spirit. The first of these, body, is the entirely unique conveyance. The third of these, Spirit, is the essential conscious energy composing all existence, including the spacetime and matter shared by all existence, including every form of life. The second of these, mind, is the bridge built between the other two, and is where the perfectly unique meets the perfectly ubiquitous, the individualized consciousness interacting with and receiving and sending information to/from both the unique body and universal Spirit.**



**Within the Trinity of Self there's the Lens Life-Form Model. It states that the Trinity of Self operates like a lens held under the sun, or any other super-condensed source of light and energy. Imagine holding a magnifying glass under the sun and directing the focused rays upon whatever the particular mind is intent on turning that energy into. The sun is the focal point of life and energy for the subject life-form; the relative localization of Spirit, or 'Ra.' It's the source of energy for every local lens, represented by the rays it casts. In the body it's most localized in the heart. The body is the lens itself. The higher quality its material and construction, the better maintained it is, the more capable it is of receiving and conducting the rays from the Sun. The mind is how the lens is hued and focused; how it's cleaned, polished and dialed in; and the better cleaned, polished and dialed in the lens is, the greater its conductive capacity. So it is that the capacity of the lens relates to the ability of every life-form to receive, conduct and focus the power of God towards the will of its Trinity. Imagine the difference in the focusing of the rays of the sun between "your lens is true, clean and well-hued" and "your lens is cracked, warped and occluded."**

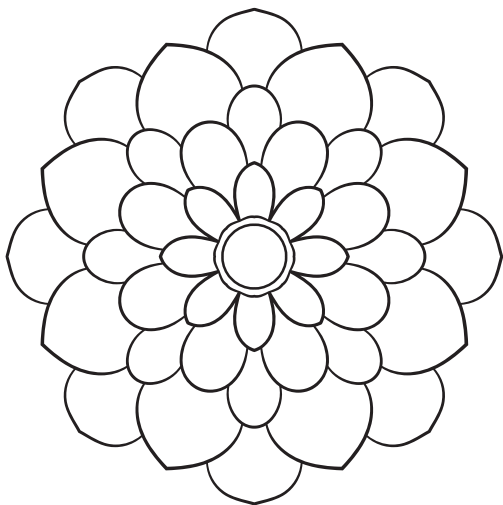

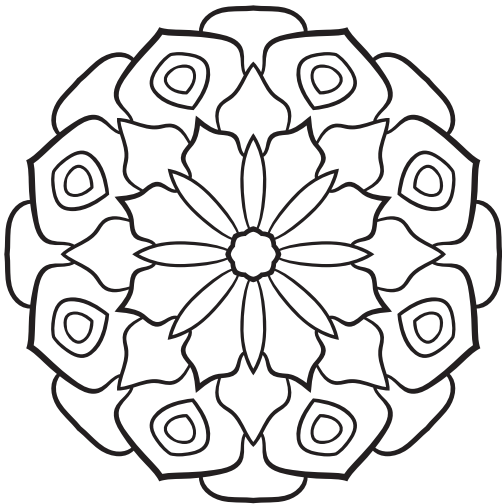




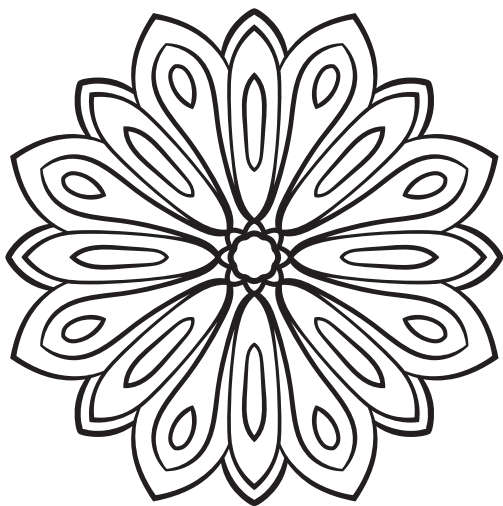
**Causality is truth and necessity. Things exist as they do because they could not exist otherwise, from the formation of the great cosmic game of dominos. Events occur as they do because they couldn't otherwise have been, from the falling of the first domino. We do as we do because we couldn't have chosen otherwise, from God, the One, pushing over the first domino: creating the existential basis for Infinite of One. The truth is that mortality and existence are gifts, and that your soul is THE soul is Spirit, or God, the essence of all. And this isn't something we need to escape, but, rather, to be grateful for.**



**The greatest teachers illumine not the outer world, like holding a torch to the world of ignorant darkness. These teachers are valuable, but not the MOST valuable. Rather, the greatest teachers remove the occlusions blocking the torch you've always held within, such that the darkness is dispelled not by them directly, but indirectly, through your use and awareness of your own torch.**



**The more joy you take in the simplest of pleasures, the closer to the center you are.**

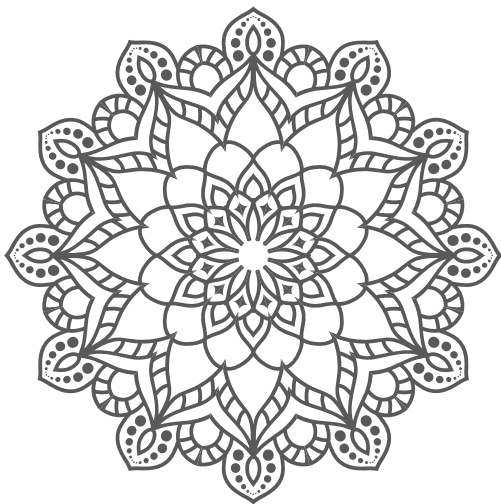




**Instinct is knowing without knowing how you know. And that's a deep, deep well. Far deeper than any education.**



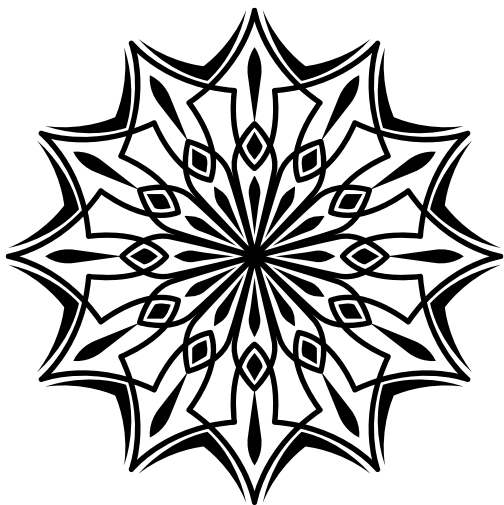

**You will be everything that you believe that you are. There's nothing else for you to be. It's ALL a self-fulfilling prophecy, you see, from God to each of Its forms.**

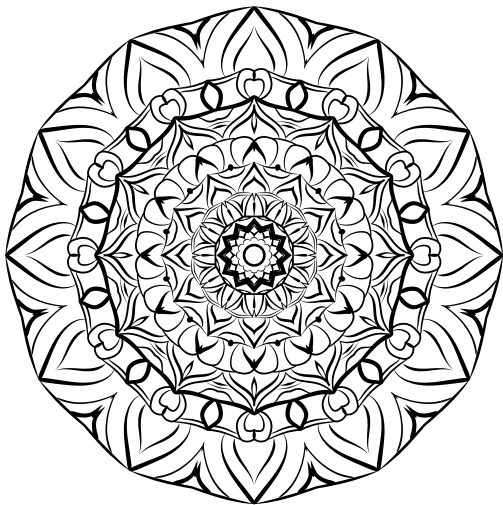




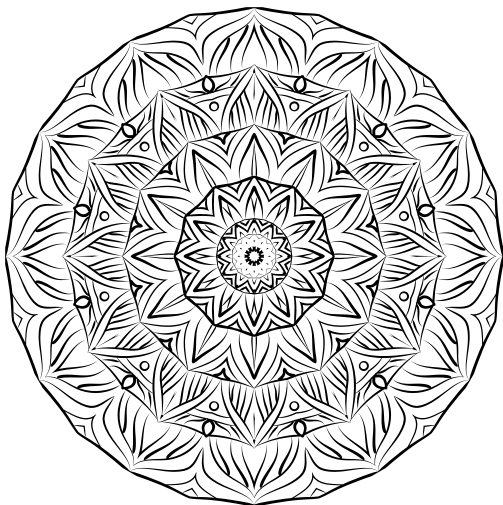

**Existence is a competition between ideas. Ideas are the realest things; the things greater than things; the ideal forms of the consciousness; the components with which we collectively construct reality.**

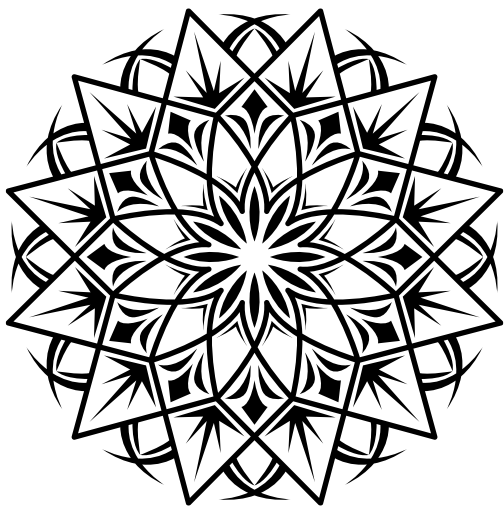
